Life Question:

Are you willing to acknowledge that if you are not serving God and loving others, it may be due to your pride?

Galatians 6:4-5 Avoid Pride and Comparison

Paul warns against comparing oneself to others, as it can lead to:

- Insecurity and A Distorted View of Others
- Valuing Ourselves As Less Than God Does
- Focusing Primarily On Outward Appearances
- Being Distracted From God's Work

Life Point:

Discover real fulfillment by embracing God's purpose in your life, rather than constantly seeking the approval of others!
